

Hosting Agreement for visiting researchers in Sweden

Appendix to application

This Hosting Agreement shall be used when researchers from countries outside the European Union (EU) or the European Economic Area (EEA) are invited by a research organisation (institute, organisation, company, etc.) to conduct research in Sweden for a period of more than three months.

This Hosting Agreement is a precondition for the research organisation being able to receive the visiting researcher and for the researcher to be able to get a residence permit. The agreement is part of the visiting researcher's application for a residence permit and must be used together with the Swedish Migration Board's form 'Application for a residence permit for a visiting researcher' (MIGR 126011).

Through the agreement, the research organisation undertakes to receive the visiting researcher and the visiting researcher undertakes to conduct the research project. The agreement must therefore be signed by both the research organisation and the visiting researcher. Provisions on a Hosting Agreement are contained in the Approval of Research Organisations to Receive Visiting Researchers Act (2008:290).
