
Autotest



1. Travis on GitHub

- 9 tests (up to level 1)
- For every check in

2. Hourly test

- 58 tests (up to level 2)
- Every hour

3. Daily test

- 77 tests (up to level 3)
- Every day: ~18:10

Main questions:

Are we testing the right things?

- Are the PC test cases sufficient? Do we need more/other?
- Are these test sorted with correct priority? (travis, hourly, daily)?
- NaN initialisations (ifort -init=(s)nan -init=array -Cb)?
- GPU / Astaroth?
