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

Motivation & Philosophy

Community

Create and foster a supportive community among junior researchers

Interdisciplinary collaboration

Encourage broad and interdisciplinary research discussions and learn from other fields



Accessibility and fun

Ensure accessible (not too technical) talks to keep them interesting, inspiring, and fun

Mentorship and Collaboration

Provide a needed platform to facilitate connections and enable participants to find collaborators and mentors



Audience

(Focus): Junior audience only bachelor/master/PhD students & postdocs

- Junior-only spaces reduce social anxiety, making junior researchers more likely to ask questions [Archbell & Coplan, 2021]
- Fosters peer learning and mentorship, shown to be an effective learning tool [Topping, 2007]
- Promotes leadership and organizational skills development by giving juniors responsibilities [Ambrose et al. 2010]
- Peer-only environments can reduce the feeling of isolation and imposter phenomenon [Gardner et al. 2019]

(Sometimes): Open to all


- Promotes knowledge exchange across different experience levels
- Encourages cross-career networking and mentorship
- Fosters a sense of community and inclusivity




Range of talks: 72 talks in last 2 years...





Promotion at bachel

On Friday afternoons, students from undergraduate and postgraduate programs gather at Nordita for Swedish fika and open lectures. The concept is called ScientiFika and the event is not only about broadening one's knowledge, but also about meeting across different subject areas to exchange ideas and experiences.







Perception and Feedback

"As an audience member, I have found the talks I've seen so far to be much more rewarding than a typical research seminar."

"Nice way to wind down on Friday. Keeping it to juniors helps make it more relaxed than if professors were there."

"It is great to see the different directions a graduation in physics can take you. Like science communication."

"As a master student, Scientific Fika is one of the few seminars which are easy to attend and that I know of thanks to their emails. I also come in contact with other students and juniors in a more easy/fun setting than other seminars."

What do we do that is different from other activities at the University?

- **Go beyond the 'standard'** talks, actively search for speakers from unique research areas (in all places! Parties and climbing halls are very effective)
- Help speakers to make their talks fun and accessible, and to fit within the ScientiFika spirit
- **Address relevant issues and interests:** questions about academia, what to do after your studies, what does it look like to work in industry, etc.
- **Create a safe and interactive environment** (encourage questions throughout, especially from students, fika afterwards to encourage mingling, events without supervisors/bosses present)



Future Plans and Ideas

- Christmas event at Proviant (December 13th!)
- Coaching platform for talks: practice with speakers beforehand and provide feedback forms
- Special event idea: Physics question meetup, where students can discuss physics questions they may be too embarrassed to ask about in class
- Consider reaching a broader audience of natural sciences
- New survey amongst participants and suggestion box on the website
- ScientiFika to the city (ScientiBeer?): organise scientific outreach events in Stockholm

ScientiFika has become a trusted platform for mentorship, collaboration, and informal networking






But...

Community

Hiring practices in OKC

→ transparent discussion of hiring practices, involvement of junior researchers in hiring processes (either directly or through feedback surveys)

Regular EDI Workshops and Forums

→ provide spaces and professional support to put our research in wider societal context, either historically or within current events.

Feedback forms

→ provide safe (with an option of anonymized) feedback forms where people can provide thoughts about the current state of OKC (e.g. sent once per semester)
