European Strategy for Particle Physics

- ▶ In March 2024, the CERN Council launched the process for the third update of the European Strategy for Particle Physics (ESPP).
- ▶ The European Strategy Group (ESG) and the Strategy Secretariat have been established in June 2024.
 - ▶ Richard Brenner (UU) is the Swedish representant in the ESG.
- ▶ The conveners of 9 physics group have been selected and endorsed by the CERN Council in September 2024. The scientific secretaries have been appointed from the ECR community.
 - ▶ Rebeca Gonzalez Suarez (UU) is one of the two conveners of the BSM working group.
- ▶ The ESPP Open Symposium will take place in Venice on June 23-27, 2025.
- ▶ A "Briefing Book" will be prepared by the Physics Preparatory Group (PPG) during a drafting session scheduled on December 1-5, 2025 and will be submitted to the CERN Council in January 2026.

ESPP – national inputs

- ▶ The community is asked to submit input by March 31, 2025. A major component of the community input is the "national inputs", which are expected to be collected individually by each country (or by regions).
- ▶ ECFA has put together a set of guidelines for the collection of the national inputs.
- ▶ Today is the first town-hall meeting to discuss the input from Sweden.
- ▶ More meetings should follow:
 - ▶ Nordic ESPP meeting under discussion...
 - ▶ Spring 2025 to discuss ESPP inputs (deadline for comments on May 26),
 - ▶ Autumn 2025 after the release of the Briefing Book (deadline for comments on November 14).
- ▶ In parallel, the ESPP secretariat has mandated RECFA delegates to collect data on the number of participants in particle physics in each country, stay tuned.
